In hot weather, the interior temperature of some apparatus cases causes equipment malfunction. Fitting these sunshades is intended to reduce heating effects due to 'solar gain'. They have been designed for retrospective fitting to existing cases manufactured to standard designs.

MANUFACTURER

Henry Williams Ltd shall:

- ensure that the latest relevant standards/ drawings are available and worked to, and that the product is compliant.
- notify the Network Rail Acceptance Specialist identified in the Acceptance Advice Note:
 - within 48 hours, of any deficiencies affecting the product quality, functionality and safety integrity of the product (including corrective action undertaken or proposed).
 - o of any intended change to the accepted product. Changes include:
 - a) a change to the product configuration (to the actual product or its application);
 - b) a variation to or addition of manufacturing locations or processes; and
 - c) a change in the name or ownership of the manufacturing company.
- ensure that each sunshade is supplied complete with fixing bolts and shake-proof star lock washers.

USER CLAUSES

GENERAL

- Sunshades to this design have overhanging edges and must not be fitted to apparatus
 cases to which the public have access (e.g. station platforms) or foul of Authorised
 Walking Routes where passers-by may not be wearing safety helmets.
- To ensure electrical bonding to the main case, the supplied star washers must be used on each end of the fixing bolts.
- Users of the product are responsible for ensuring compliance with the certificate conditions. If a condition is not understood guidance must be sought from the Acceptance Specialist identified in the Acceptance Advice Note.
- Each party in the Network Rail supply chain procuring and receiving the product is responsible for ensuring that it is fit for purpose and that the application of use complies with the scope of acceptance. Any product defect should be taken up immediately with the supplier. If the defect is a design or manufacturing fault likely to affect performance and/or the safe operation of the railway this shall be reported in writing to the Acceptance Specialist identified in the Acceptance Advice Note.
- Anyone becoming aware of a change to the product configuration (to the actual product or its application); and a variation to or addition of manufacturing locations or processes, should inform the Acceptance Specialist in writing.
